

NOTICE OF MEETING


NOTICE is hereby given that the Cherokee County Commissioners' Court will meet in Regular Session at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 24, 2019 at its regular meeting place in the County Courtroom in the County Courthouse in the City of Rusk, Texas, for the purpose of:

1. Call to Order.
2. Invocation.
3. Consider laying utility lines in each precinct.
4. Consider approval of setting the tax rate for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 (Roll call vote).
5. Consider approval for the Auditor's Office to conduct an audit on all Chapter 59 Forfeiture Funds as required by Article 59.06(g) (1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
6. Consider approval of Special Budgets as required by law- Special Revenue Fund(GASB54), Law Enforcement Education (Texas Occupations Code §1701.157) and DA, Sheriff LEF and Constables LEF (Texas Criminal Code §59(d)).
7. Consider approval of Texas Extension Education Association (TEEA) Week Proclamation for October 7-11, 2019.
8. Discussion and acceptance of Designated Representative for Cherokee County resignation.
9. Consider approval of transfer truck from Sheriff Office to Precinct 3.
